Apply this product directly to the lawn or garden area. Water treated area as directed on this label. Do not water to the point of run-off. Do not apply more than 550 pounds of Signature Talstar 0.073% plus Fertilizer-LC per acre per year. Not for use on golf courses, sod farms, nurseries, commercial greenhouses or grass grown for seed.

LAWN AND PERIMETER APPLICATIONS

Perimeter Application: Apply to ground area 6 to 10 feet wide around and adjacent to the structure using an application rate of 3.13 to 6.25 pounds per 1,000 square feet.

Grass Application: Broadcast Signature Talstar 0.073% plus Fertilizer-LC with suitable application equipment to ensure uniform coverage over the treatment area. Apply 3.13 to 6.25 pounds per 1,000 square feet to control the following pests.

Comments

¹ **Deer ticks (*Ixodes* sp.)** have a complicated life cycle that ranges over a two year period and involves four life stages. Applications should be made in mid to late spring to control larvae and nymphs that reside in the soil and leaf litter.

² **Imported Fire Ants:** Control will be optimized by combining broadcast applications that will control foraging workers and newly mated fly-in queens with mound treatments (using Talstar Professional Insecticide) that will eliminate existing colonies.

³ The higher application rate may be required to control Ants, Centipedes, Fleas, Imported Fire Ants, Millipedes, Mole Crickets & Ticks (including Deer Ticks).

In New York State, this product may NOT be applied to any grass or turf area within 100 feet of a water body (lake, pond, river, stream, wetland, or drainage ditch).

In New York State, do make a single repeat application of Signature Talstar 0.073% plus Fertilizer-LC if there are signs of renewed insect activity, but not sooner than two weeks after the first application.
